

English

As writers, our learning will be centred around our core texts of 'The Gingerbread Man' and The Storm Whale' by Benji Davies



Through this, we will:

- Explore characters and create character descriptions • using a range of adjectives.
- Explore riddles and write our own riddle. •
- Order and write a familiar story. •
- Write a setting description using a range of adjectives. •
- Learn about poetry and write our own poem.
- Create our own character and add them into a story. •
- Explore character decisions and write using the conjunction 'because'





Reading

- As readers, we will focus on:
- Reading a range of fiction, non-fiction and poetry to develop our levels of fluency.
- Draw on inferences from character's • feelings, thoughts and motives from their actions
- Enhance our vocabulary to deepen our understanding and word meaning.

Our reading for pleasure texts will be 'The three little wolves and the big bad pig' and 'The true story of the three little pigs'

Science

As scientists, our unit is 'Identifying plants'

Through this, we will:

- Explore what a plant is.
- Identify and describe garden plants, wild plants and trees.
- Look at the differences between deciduous and evergreen trees.
- Make observations of plants growing. •
- Identify the different parts and features of a plant.



History

As historians, our unit is 'castles'

Through this, we will:

- Explore different types of castles.
- Look at the features of castles.
- Learn about the people who lived in castles.
- Look at changes to castles over time.
- Explore why people attacked castles.
- Look at artefacts to enhance our understanding of castles and items within them.



Maths

As mathematicians, we will follow White Rose units. This term our learning will focus on: fractions, multiplication and division and geometry – position and direction. time, money and place value to 100.

Through this, we will:

- Learn to count in 2's. 5's and 10's. Recognise and make equal groups. Add equal groups, create arrays and make doubles.
- Find half of an object and half of a quantity and find • a guarter of an object and a guarter of the guantity. Explore the number line to 100 and count from 50-100.
- Explore the place value of numbers up to 100.
- Tell the time to the hour and half hour.
- Learn the days of the week and months of the year.
- Recognise the value of notes and coins

Phonics

We are following the 'Little Wandle' phonics scheme. The children will be learning phase 5 phonemes and the corresponding graphemes. The children will use their phonetic knowledge and apply this within their writing. Spelling practise is built into daily phonics lessons.



Geography

As geographers, our unit is 'settlements'

Through this, we will:

- Know where people live around the world. •
- Explore the features of different settlements.
- Look at the human and physical features of Peterborough.
- Explore maps and look at maps of our local area. •
- Draw our own map of our local area.
