Maths

We have been thinking about the composition of the number five. We have been singing '5 Little Speckled Frogs' in order to support our understanding of how five can be composed in many different ways. We have also been learning about 'more' and 'fewer' and playing lots of games to aid our understanding of these concepts.

English:

We spent some time improving our culinary skills in the kitchen before writing simple recipes to match our experiences. We wrote instructions on how to make porridge and also on how to make egg muffins. The children were then challenged to design their own egg muffin recipes during their independent playing and learning time and they came up with some fantastic recipes. They wrote sentences independently, applying their phonics skills and knowledge of letter formation. What amazing little writers we have!
