Dear Parents / Carers,

At Braybrook Primary School, we are constantly striving to improve our performance and value the comments and feedback that you give us through the letters and surveys that go home during the year. Whilst we know that there are inevitably areas identified that we need to continue to work on, it is always wonderful to receive recognition for the things that are going well and the hard work that is put in by all staff and stakeholders during the academic year.

We were thrilled to receive **173 replies** to our Parent Survey during this month's parents' consultations, as compared to 93 responses this time last year. We were delighted by this level of response and can now share with you some of the key findings, which evidence our continued improvements in all areas, almost without exception, as compared with last year.

Happily, the survey shows that:

100% of parents:

- feel that their child is well looked after at this school, with 99% of parents agreeing or strongly agreeing that their child feels safe at Braybrook.
- feel that their child is making good progress at this school.
- recognise that the school helps their child to develop skills in Communication, Reading, Writing & Maths.

99% of parents:

- feel that their child is taught well at this school
- agree or strongly agree that the school meets their child's particular needs.
- would recommend our school to another parent.

In addition to these successes, the very large majority of parents praised the good standard of behaviour at Braybrook and the advice that is given to them to best support with learning at home. This only further reinforces the great work of the entire 'Braybrook Family' and the strength of your continued partnership and commitment to our school.

That said, in the light of your feedback, over the rest of the year we will continue to work to:

- further develop our strategies and systems to inform and communicate with parents, through parent open sessions, parent forum opportunities, revised termly progress reports and regular communication and updates through both our website and media pods.
- clarify the school's approaches to preventing bullying in our school, to heighten awareness and understanding of the term 'bullying' and to ensure that parents are clear of the seriousness with which this issue is regarded and the ways in which you can support us in ensuring rigour in responding to this, should the need arise.

So far, we have had a fantastic year. With your continued support and feedback, we now look forward to the exciting activities and events that the rest of the year brings.
