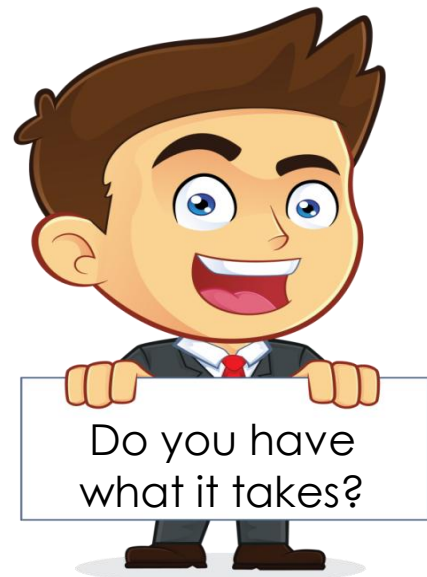
Although useful, it is not necessary to have great computing skills but if you are:
