

As Upper KS2 **MFL** Learners we will learn to:

Listen and Respond

- understand short passages containing phrases and questions we have learnt.
- respond to questions using extended sentences.
- listen to a passage and identify the subject and the main points.

Speak

- have a short conversation of three or four exchanges, using phrases we have learnt.
- vary phrases or sentences we have learnt for different circumstances.
- pronounce words correctly and speak with increasing fluency.

Read and Respond

- understand short texts that use phrases we have learnt.
- use a glossary to find meanings of unfamiliar words.
- read short poems and traditional stories.
- use contextual clues to help work out the meanings of unfamiliar words.

Write

- write two or three short sentences, using words and phrases we have learnt.
- write a paragraph of three or four sentences.
- use books, posters or a word bank to help our writing.
- use our knowledge of grammar to change words and phrases, e.g. using plurals and adding adjectives.

Develop cultural understanding

- talk about special festivals and events.
- record our understanding through drawing and simple sentences in a paragraph.
- independently use sources, such as books or the internet, to research special events.
- talk about aspects of everyday life in another country.
