1. Mrs Day sends a message from the office, asking why your child is absent from school.
2. If we do not hear back, a phone call is made and, if we cannot get hold of you, a message is left asking you to contact the school.
3. If no contact is made to give a reason for the absence, we carry out a home visit. This is so we are sure all is well with you and your child.
4. If, when we come to the house, we still cannot make contact but believe children are in the home, we have a duty of care to ensure that they are safe and well. To do this we have guidelines to follow, where we will contact the police for a safe and well check. They will come round to the house to try and make contact and ensure that you and your child are safe and well.
