<u>Reading</u>

As readers, we will focus on:

- Reading a range of fiction, non-fiction and poetry to develop our levels of fluency.
- Draw on inferences from character's feelings, thoughts and motives from their actions
- Enhance our vocabulary to deepen our understanding and word meaning.

texts will be ' the owl and the pussycat' 'look up' and 'grandads island'



<u>Maths</u>

As mathematicians, we will follow White Rose units. This half term our learning will focus on: time, money and place value to 100.

Through this, we will:

- Explore the number line to 100 and count from 50-100.
- Explore the digits within numbers and what they represent.
- Tell the time to the hour and half hour.
- Learn the days of the week and months of the year.
- Recognise the value of notes and coins.

Phonics

We are following the 'Little Wandle' phonics scheme. The children will be learning phase 5 phonemes and the corresponding graphemes. The children will use their phonetic knowledge and apply this within their writing. Spelling practise is built into daily phonics lessons.

The phonics screening check will take place W/C 12.6.23



Science

As scientists, our Plan Bee unit is 'Seasonal changes'

Through this, we will:

- Find out about different seasons and how to describe them.
- Find out how animals and humans are affected by the seasons.
- Find out how day length is affected by the seasons.
- Investigate the weather during the seasons.



History

As historians, our Plan Bee unit is 'Seaside

Through this, we will:

- Find out when seaside holidays became popular and use photographs to explore changes over time.
- Take part in a case study on Hunstanton beach and how it has changed over time.
- Find out what seaside holidays were like in the past.
- Identify similarities and differences between holidays in the past and now.



Geography

As geographers, our Plan Bee unit is

Through this, we will:

- Locate and identify oceans and continents.
- Find out about British beaches using fieldwork skills
- Compare a British beach with one from another country.
- Use compass points to move around a map.

To consolidate our learning and to support children in knowing more and remembering more, we will have the following home learning:

- E reading books will be sent out, these will directly link to our reading practice lessons within school to encourage a deeper knowledge of the text.
- Reading for pleasure children will choose a book to share and read for enjoyment at home.
- Regular maths learning on Numbots. 10-minute blocks 2-3 times a week.
- Practising the phonics sounds and tricky words that the children will be assigned.
