Maths

Over the last two weeks, the children in Year 3 have worked hard on refining their understanding of subtraction by using column method. We have also applied our understanding of addition and subtraction to word problems and finding inverse operations.

English

In English, we have been improving our understanding of diary writing through our whole class text, "Diary of a Killer Cat," by Anne Fine. The children have been writing from different perspectives and have explored ways of showing rather than telling character emotions.

Science

In our science sessions, the children have been exploring the human skeleton and had the chance to conduct an investigation to record the lengths of various bones in the human body. This linked perfectly with our recent visit to the life bus where we explored what goes on inside our bodies.

Foundation Subjects

In Geography, we have explored where our food comes from around the world. We have discussed biomes and foods which grow seasonally.

In Music, we have been exploring the Vikings and begun learning a song called "Dragon ships" complete with rowing actions!
