Maths

Opal Class are currently learning about addition and subtraction. The children are beginning to confidently add and subtract multiples of 10. We have also launched weekly times table tests. These will be every Friday. Your child will bring home their test each week and if they answer all 30 questions correctly in 3 minutes, they earn Dojos and a certificate.

English
