Maths:

We have been using the language of 'more than' and 'fewer than' to compare quantities. We have also been learning how to subitise larger quantities by looking at the smaller groups within the whole and then adding these back together.

English:

We read the story of 'The Naughty Bus.' We were shocked by the Naughty Bus' antics and we had lots of fun writing about the adventures of The Naughty Bus during our writing sessions. We have been building our stamina and practicing writing three sentences during our writing sessions.
