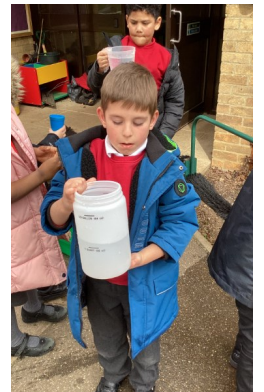
A warm welcome back to school for the summer term at Braybrook. We hope you all had a restful Easter break.

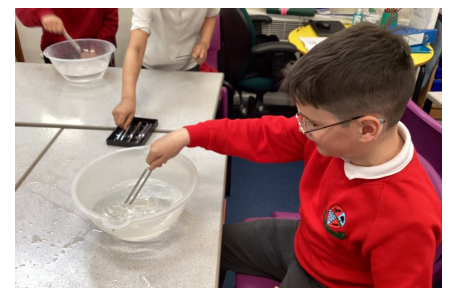
