



We are pleased to invite pupils to take part in our upcoming Braybrook Colour Run fundraising event, in collaboration with the PTA. This will take part on 25<sup>th</sup> June starting straight after school on the school field (starting from 3:15pm onwards). Children will run the course with their class, and be released to their parents after they have finished. Unfortunately, parents will not be able to run the course this year.

If you cannot come to spectate, we are hosting a separate run at 2:30pm with school staff (no spectators).

During the event, children will walk, jog or run around a supervised course while coloured powder is gently thrown at participants. The powder used is non-toxic and suitable for this type of event.

### **ENTRY**

**The cost to enter is £6 per child.** This includes:

- Entry to the Colour Run
- Coloured powder
- Protective glasses
- A finishers medal

Please send the money into school in a named envelope.

### **FUNDRAISING**

We are also encouraging children to take part in sponsorship fundraising for an extra incentive.

For every student raising £10, they will receive their own Colour Run t-shirt!

For those raising £20, they will also receive a set of accessories for the colour run!

Those who raise £30 or more will receive all of the above plus a draw-string bag of goodies!

**Braybrook Colour Run Application Form and Waiver**

**A waiver needs to be signed and returned to school by 19<sup>th</sup> June for EACH person taking part i.e. ONE FORM PER PERSON RUNNING. If you do not return this, your child will not be able to participate.**

In order your child to participate in the Braybrook Colour Run, you must complete the following waiver prior to the event (for each child).

1. I am aged 18 years or above and wish for my child to participate in the Braybrook Colour Run and I am the parent/legal guardian of the registered child who is/are under the age of 18. I wish for the named children to participate in the Braybrook Colour Run on 25<sup>th</sup> June 2026.
2. I agree that my child will participate in the Braybrook Colour Run in accordance with the specific safety rules clearly explained by school staff at the beginning of the challenge.
3. I understand that participating in the Braybrook Colour Run is a potentially hazardous activity where coloured powder will be thrown at and around my child during the event. However, I understand that the powder is not harmful to people, animals or plant life.
4. I agree that my child will wear any safety equipment outlined by Braybrook Colour Run. In accordance with the safety instructions and risk assessment, all participants must wear protective eyewear. This can include sunglasses (these will be provided), or goggles / prescription eyewear if preferred. I understand that children need to wear protective eyewear at all times. Failure to comply with these instructions could result in the participation being denied.
5. I agree to provide a t-shirt (preferably white) to wear on the course. I understand that the colour powder can cause staining if not washed on a cool cycle, immediately after the event.
6. Participants are expected to exhibit appropriate behavior at all times and must always follow the instructions that are given to them. They must show respect towards the other pupils taking part, school staff, equipment and facilities and not misuse these in any way.
7. I confirm that my child is in good physical condition and has no medical impairments that may prevent them from participating in the activity. If I have any concerns about their physical condition, I will consult my doctor before participating in the activity and inform the school straight away. I acknowledge that participation in the activity may be physically demanding and that there are risks of injury.
8. I hereby indemnify Friends of Braybrook School Association against all claims made by any other person against Friends of Braybrook School Association in respect of any injury, loss or damage arising out of or in connection with my failure to comply with the safety instructions and/or directions given by the school staff and event organisers.
9. I acknowledge that I have read, fully understood and agree with all of the above prior to signing below.
