We have had another fantastic week at school, with every year group enjoying exciting opportunities both in and beyond the classroom.

Reception and Year 1 had a wonderful day at Baytree Owl and Raptor Centre in Spalding, where the children came face to face with a variety of magnificent birds, including owls, eagles, vultures, hawks and falcons. They thoroughly enjoyed two flying displays and a tour of the centre, learning more about the different species and their habitats. It was a memorable experience and a highlight of the week for many.



Our Year 2 and Year 3 classes also enjoyed a day out this week with a visit to Sacrewell Farm. The children had a fantastic time exploring the farm, including a visit to the historic mill, and meeting many of the animals, including pigs, alpacas, peacocks, chickens and horses. They also enjoyed looking at the vintage tractors and, of course, spending some time on the park.



Year 4 certainly did not miss out on the excitement, enjoying a wonderful day at Burghley House as part of their learning on the Tudors. The children met Henry VIII and discovered more about his fascinating life before exploring the house and its incredible Tudor rooms. After lunch overlooking the deer park, they learned about Tudor foods and even took part in some traditional Tudor dances and games.



Back at school, our Year 5 class have had a productive week. In English, the children have been creating advertisements based on inventions they designed themselves, producing some wonderfully persuasive pieces. In maths, they have continued their work on decimals, carefully solving problems and presenting their work neatly to minimise mistakes. In geography, they have been learning about East Anglia, exploring the human and physical features found across the region.

A huge well done also goes to our Year 5 pupils who successfully completed their Level 5 Bikeability course: Jake, Hanna, Annalee, Teddy and Alfie. They demonstrated excellent cycling skills and road awareness throughout the programme.



Meanwhile, Year 6 have been hard at work preparing for their end-of-year production, Grimm. We are incredibly excited to share the performance with you, as the children have been putting tremendous effort into learning their roles and bringing the show to life. In English, the class recently completed a whole-school writing project, creating imaginative non-chronological reports about their own species of dragon. Emerald class excelled in this task, writing like true dragonologists and using an impressive range of scientific and technical vocabulary. Their creations ranged from tiny desert dragons to fearsome dream dragons that hunt under the cover of darkness!
